The oil is extracted out of the centre shell of the fruit and is rich in vitamin C and E, natural antioxidant and fatty acids. Light in texture, fast-absorbing and hydrating, this luxury oil is considered to be the elixir of youth.

Archaeological recordings confirm evidence of stone old Marula pits, carving tools and heaps of shells.

The African women still make use of the healing powers of the oil, in their traditional ways today. The oil is slowly being massaged into the hair and scalp,onto the face, feet and hands. The ancient rituals are passed on to the next generation and thus kept alive.

#### DO YOU KNOW

REACHING A HEIGHT OF UP TO 20 METRES THE MONGONGO IS A POPULAR SHADE TREE - amongst the Kavango people in the northern region of Namibia. The unripe fruits drop down into the thick soft sand below, where they are collected by women of the Kavango- and !Khung tribe. These juicy and tasteful fruits contain a nut inside. The nuts are being crushed to reach the oil, which is traditionally used for body scrubs and massages. The oil is also suitable for scalp and hair treatments. Passed down generations African women have carried their knowledge about the power of Mongongo oil for thousands of years to pass on the secrets to their daughters. The exceptionally high content of vitamin E, unsaturated fatty acids, calcium, magnesium, iron, Copper, riboflavin, and niacin is extremely nourishing and provides a deep cleanse and full skin protection.

!NARA OIL - DELICACY OF THE "TOPNAAR" PEOPLE - The !Nara plant is endemic to Namibia and grows in the dry desert region along the Atlantic coastline. Almost lime green in colour, this thorny creeper bears spiky fruits which are highly nutritious and eaten by many animals of the Namibian desert. The !Nara fruit and seeds also are a delicacy for the "Topnaar" people. They live in a small village, scattered along the lower Kuiseb river. These traditional stock farmers harvest the seeds of the !Nara fruit, allow them to dry and then pack them into bags to be transported to the nearest town. The cold pressed oil of the !Nara seeds has a high Omega 6 content, which helps to rejuvenate dry, sensitive, irritated skin. Traditionally, this oil is used for wound treatment and general skin protection. By supporting a social project the "Topnaar" people are able to earn a steady income.
